1. Wines 1 – 4 are all made from the same single grape variety and come from different countries.

With reference to all four wines:

- a) Identify the grape variety (20)

Then for each wine:

- b) Identify the origin as closely as possible (4 x 10)
- c) Comment on the quality, within the context of the region of origin (4 x 10)

2. Wines 5 and 6 are from the same region, same producer and same single grape variety.

For both wines:

- a) Identify the grape variety (15)
- b) Identify the specific origin as closely as possible (15)
- c) Compare the style and quality with specific reference to the method of production (20)

3. Wines 7 and 8 are from the same region, same single grape variety and same vintage.

For both wines:

- a) Identify the specific origins as closely as possible (20)
- b) Comment on the quality and state of maturity (15)
- c) Identify the vintage, giving reasons (15)

4. Wines 9 – 12 are a mixed bag. Each is from a different country and a different single or predominant grape variety.

For each wine:

- a) Identify the single or predominant grape variety (4 x 10)
- b) Identify the origin as closely as possible (4 x 10)

With reference to all four wines:

- c) Comment on the winemaking and the commercial appeal of the wines (20)
