1. Wines 1 – 4 are all from the same country and region.

With reference to all four wines, discuss style, origin, winemaking, quality and commercial appeal. (100)

2. Wines 5 – 8 are all fortified wines.

For each wine:

- a) Identify the origin as closely as possible (4 x 8)
- b) Identify the most relevant production techniques evident in the wine (4 x 9)
- c) Comment on the quality within the context of the region, stating the alcohol and residual sugar levels. (4 x 8)

3. Wines 9 and 10 are from the same region of origin.

For both wines:

- a) Identify the origin as closely as possible (15)
- b) Compare the most relevant winemaking techniques involved in the production of these wines (20)
- c) Compare the maturity and quality, clearly stating which is the higher quality wine (15)

4. Wines 11 and 12 are from the same country, which is not France, Spain, Italy or Australia.

For both wines:

- a) Consider the possible origin (15)
- b) Comment on the style, quality and commercial appeal (35)
